This Scholarship is possible because of the hard work and dedication of our membership. The Laborers' Local #270 Executive Board awards it annually to be applied toward the tuition, books and educational Expenses of the student selected to be its recipient.

If you wish to apply, you must be a high school senior, or currently enrolled full-time in an accredited college or Technical school, and also **must** be an active member of Local 270 for the last 12 months working under covered Employment or seeking covered employment, or be a child or legally adopted child, grandchild or spouse of a current Member or retiree of Local 270. The applicant must demonstrate financial need and fully complete the application.

The San Jose office of Local 270 must receive the completed application by **Monday, March 30, 2020** to be eligible.

Once eligibility is established the application will be processed and all information will be forwarded to our College Scholarship Committee to be judged. As soon as they are judged, you will be informed of the results.

Please note: if you are awarded the Scholarship, be prepared to attend the Award Ceremony on Friday, May 8, 2020 at our Local 270 headquarters: 2195 Fortune Dr, San Jose CA 95131.

14. **Please enclose a copy of proof of your enrollment (or acceptance) in an accredited College or University for Fall 2020.**
15. **Please enclose an Official Transcript from your most recent academic institution- college if you have attended or high school if you are now graduating.**

Mail with your completed application and essay to Local 270, 2195 Fortune Drive, San Jose, CA 95131. All applications must be received and postmarked no later than 5:00 pm Monday, March 30, 2020.

Note: Any Incomplete packet and/or missing any of the 15 requirements will result in disqualification. Any scholarship awarded to a student who does not, at any time during the award period, attend full-time, an accredited college, or university in the United States, will be revoked.
